LIBERIA

Located on the western coast of Africa, the country whose name literally means "Land of the Free" was established in 1822 (with the support of the American government) as a colony for free-born and formerly enslaved African Americans. From its inception, though, ethnic issues divided the population of Liberia and fueled hostility between people groups. Recent decades of war and political corruption have left Liberia poor and destitute. Road systems and buildings are in shambles. Worst of all, the people are left traumatized and scarred by a nation in constant conflict.



An estimated 200,000 people were killed during the wartime that spanned from 1989 to 2003. Over 50,000 children under the age of 17 have been killed in direct combat. And every Liberian child has been affected. Many were orphaned.

Since the fighting ended in 2003, the E.C. church has been directly involved with restoration efforts. There were 36 E.C. churches that remained after the war, but since many are back in the jungle or 'bush', they are inaccessible except on foot, so the current number is uncertain. Most of our E.C. church members belong to the Bassa tribe.

In January 2016 the church held its first election for the next leader of the Church. The new leader is Rev. Abraham Powell. Rev. Powell's vision led to the 2017 VBS project of raising funds for a literacy project. Since the war, many of the public schools have not been reopened, so there is a generation of Liberians who are functionally illiterate. Rev. Powell's plan will establish teaching centers in E.C. churches, with teachers who will teach people to read using the Bassa scriptures. In this way, the people will learn to read and learn about God at the same time. We met our goal of \$10,000 for the VBS project, and Rev. Powell reports that the program is now underway.

The E.C. Church of Liberia holds its annual conference this month, and GMC Associate Rev. Randy Sizemore, along with Liberia Committee chairman Rev. Rick Sergi, will be there to represent the E.C. Church of the USA. We look forward to hearing how God's work is progressing through our E.C. churches in that country which needs spiritual and physical healing.
