About The Seminar...

This six-hour seminar is designed to inspire and equip people to become effectively live out The Great Commission by making disciples of Jesus Christ in a purposeful manner. You will explore the Biblical principles that guide intentional discipling using proven principles and materials. This training will help launch you into an exciting and life-changing ministry of helping others become fully devoted followers of Jesus. The seminar consists of three dynamic, interactive sessions.

Session 1 addresses the motivation behind personal discipling. Interactive discussion here will help participants grasp a personal conviction of what is involved in Biblical discipling and guide each participant toward crystallizing a personal vision for a lifetime of making disciples.

Session 2 highlights critical Biblical principles. Here we explore the broad Biblical principles that will guide your personal discipling and explore practical applications of these principles in everyday life and ministry.

Session 3 pulls it all together into a Personal Action Plan. The seminar concludes with six practical guidelines for recruiting a prospective disciple and launching a ministry of intentional discipling – and helps each participant to prayerfully think through a practical “Action Plan” for putting these concepts into action.

- Maturing disciples who are practicing the basics of the Christian life and have a heart for discipling others.
- Graduates of a discipleship growth process such as the 2:7 Series discipleship course.
- Mentors who want to develop and coach new disciples.
- Pastors, elders and leaders who want to add a more focused, intentional discipling component to their ministries.

- Help you deepen your own relationship with Christ.
- Help you formulate your personal convictions and vision for Biblical discipling.
- Help you understand the Biblical principles that guide “life-to-life” discipling.

- Teach you how to create an environment in which discipleship will thrive within your personal ministry or your church.
- Explain how to develop a support structure for people beginning to disciple others.
- Help you know how to effectively invest your life in another person through a meaningful personal relationship.
- Help you select the right materials to assist you in your discipling ministry.
- Connect you with others who share your passion for making disciples.
- Clarify a personal framework for a life-to-life ministry.

- Read the short booklet, *Born to Reproduce*, which will be provided prior to the seminar.
- Prayerfully reflect on your discipling experiences and come prepared to share.
- Pray that God would clearly speak to you during this seminar.

Related Discipling Resources...

Devotional Life of a Leader Workshop. This dynamic, practical 90-minute workshop is designed to assist leaders in experiencing vibrant devotional lives and to encourage them to set the pace within their churches in developing a culture of mutual sharing from one another's spiritual journey. This training is foundational to the development of an intentional discipling environment. Interactive discussion addresses Biblical principles and examples of "quiet-time" and will also outline practical strategies and suggestions for how to have meaningful quiet-times. Includes role-plays and actual quiet time experience. Everyone will benefit from this training; however, the discussion is particularly geared to the personal demands and challenges faced by key leaders within churches.

The 2:7 Series Leader Development Seminar. This six-hour seminar prepares the Christian to use the newly updated 2:7 Series as a discipling tool. Whereas the *Discipling Others*

Seminar deals primarily with the principles that drive intentional discipling, the *2:7 Series Leader Development Seminar* provides practical hands-on training on how to use the 2:7 Series in a one-to-one discipling relationship or a small group of three to eight people.

Adventure in Discipling Others. This is a new resource that is designed to help you “coach” one or more fellow Christians who are just beginning to disciple someone else. With *The Adventure in Discipling Others* anyone can mentor and love the process. This is a natural follow-on to the *Discipling Others Seminar*.

The Intentional Discipling Church Development Process. *The Intentional Discipling Church Development Process* is designed to help local churches develop internal discipling environments that will be fruitful for generations – environments that focus on the transformation of people into Christ likeness. A dynamic Power Point presentation is available upon request to help church leaders overview this development process. The presentation defines what an “intentional discipling church” is, identifies six elements that need to be integrated throughout the life of the church, provides practical insights on how to make this a reality and outlines how the Navigators can be of on-going assistance.
