Many Christian organizations are unaware of the large numbers of seekers who visit their web sites. For example, over 43% of all the Hits received from Campus Crusade for Christ Intl.'s main page go to the "Who is Jesus...Really?" link. On average, over 35 people each day indicate a decision for Christ worldwide!
