We are currently working for World Gospel Mission on the American Indian Field. We live in Fruitland, New Mexico, just a mile off the Navajo Reservation. We have been here for three years. We are both co-leaders with Restored Warriors which is a small group ministry for survivors of childhood abuse. Randy also teaches a Monday night Bible study and Sunday school at Salvation Army church. He also preaches there occasionally when the pastor is away. We also host a gathering every other Sunday for a time of contextualized worship. We also participate in a group that is working to give more Native people the opportunity to take part in cross-cultural mission experiences. I run an after-school program for several age groups. There are about 15 girls participating in the program. More than half of the girls are Navajo. During the summer I hold a play group with several pre-school children attending.
