WHO'S YOUR DADDY?

MOST PEOPLE look at a newborn and try to find a family resemblance. "She has her mother's eyes" or "he has his father's nose" they say. As the child gets older, behavioral characteristics may be similar to a parent. "Your father used to make that same face!" a grandmother may comment. As the maturing process continues, many children look, sound and increasingly act like one or both of their parents.

The scriptures tell us that we will resemble our spiritual father as well. Jesus excoriated the religious leaders who claimed to be children of Abraham, but whose behavior mirrored someone very different. In John 8, Jesus tells them "You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desire. When he lies, he speaks his native language; for he is a liar and the father of lies." (verse 44, NIV)

On the other hand, in his letter to the Corinthian believers the apostle Paul referred to God's promise to David, "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty." (II Corinthians 6:18, NIV) He was encouraging them to stay true to their faith and to show it by their behavior. He leaves them with this command, "Aim for perfection.." (II Cor 13:11a, NIV)

If we truly are the children of our heavenly Father as we claim, we will continue to look and act more like Him, until the resemblance is undeniable.
